- ⇒ The same seat is reserved for each day of the Championships.

Day Tickets

- ⇒ The day ticket gives entry to the single event of your choice in the Berlin Olympic Stadium.
- ⇒ The competitions on Tuesday 18 August 2009 are divided into morning and evening events. Each of these events requires its own admission ticket.
- ⇒ When booking tickets for several days events, you do not have the right to reserve the same seat.

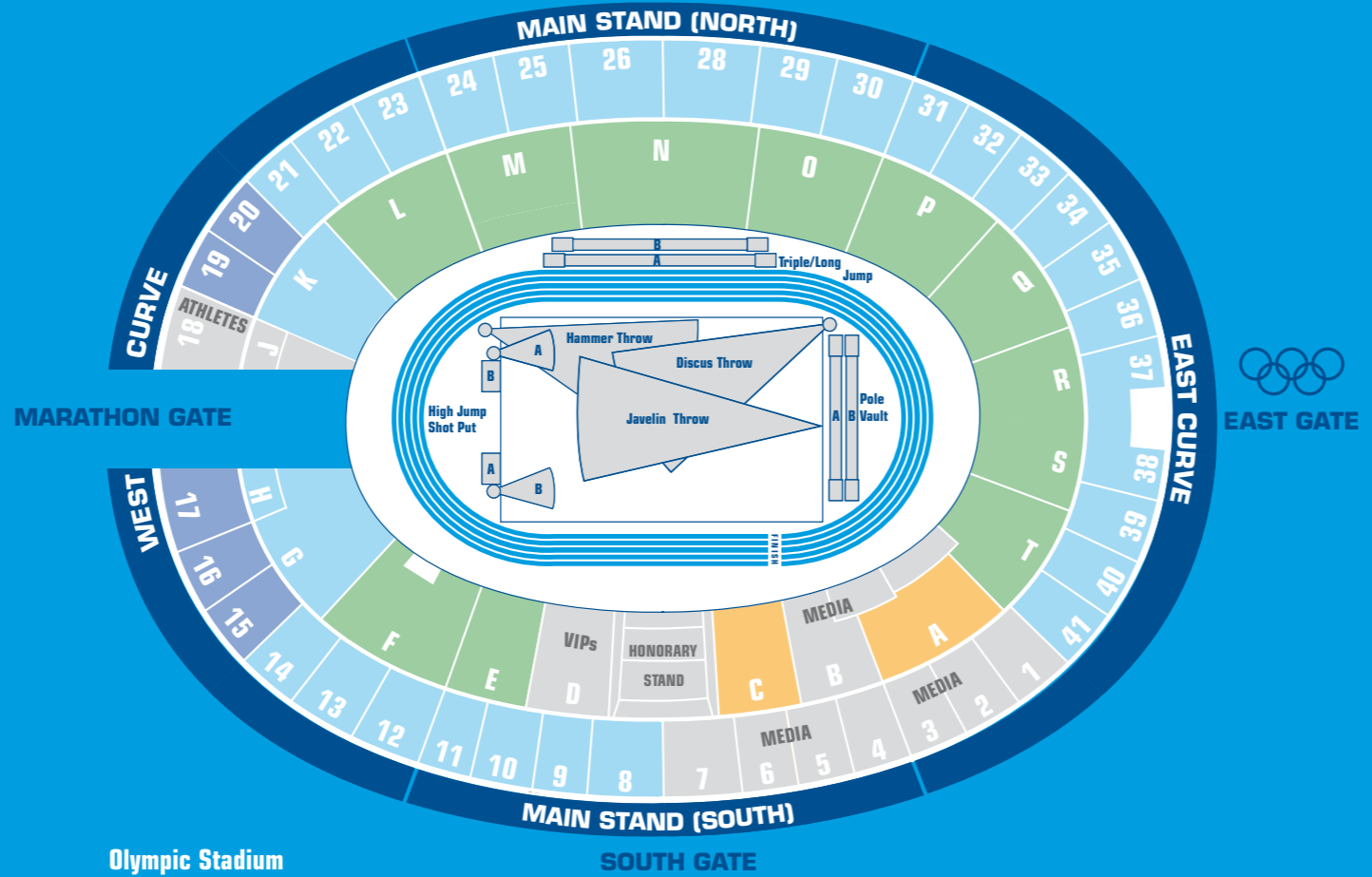

Ticket Concessions and more Information

- ⇒ Ticket concessions are available for school students and students (up to 27 years of age), disabled persons (with 50% disability or over), trainees (up to 27 years of age), young persons (up to 16 years of age), persons engaged in military or alternative civilian service and unemployed persons. Please note that reduced price tickets will only be issued on submission of valid proof of eligibility. Such proof must also be furnished if requested by the staff at admission control. Combination of different ticket concessions is not allowed.

- ⇒ 20% reduction on all standard day tickets. Does not apply to the category "Finish Line Area".
- ⇒ Children under 6 do not need a valid ticket to gain entry to the event but have no right to a separate seat.
- ⇒ Ticket prices not including 13% advance booking fee
- ⇒ All tickets include free transport to and from the event with Berlin's VBB public transport system (tariff zone Berlin-ABC).

The **12th IAAF World Championships in Athletics berlin 2009[®]** will offer nine days of unbroken passion, emotion and fascination, spills and thrills, victories and defeats and world-class entertainment. No wonder that these Championships for the key Olympic discipline are the world's most important sporting mega-event second only to the Olympic Games themselves and football's World Cup.



Be there yourself right in the thick of the action and experience the unique atmosphere of the legendary Olympic Stadium with its distinctive blue track when the best athletes in the world take you on an unforgettable roller-coaster ride of emotion.

Berlin – Global Capital with a Truly Unique Flair

"Berlin, Berlin, we're going to Berlin" this song that football fans sing on their way to the yearly cup final can now be sung with even more gusto and enthusiasm by the guests of this young and dynamic city. Berlin fulfils all expectations – no matter if you're coming for a quick weekend break or a longer stay of several weeks. Over 146 million visitors a year from all corners of the world come to experience the unmistakable flair of this great city now securely established as one of the world's great tourist destinations. Berlin's rich and diverse offering of accommodation of all classes and categories is truly unrivalled.

Berlin was always a prime destination for tourists from the whole world and the city has long been famous as a byword for new trends and sheer creativity. A wide array of exhibitions, art galleries, leading trade fairs, entertainment of all kinds and first class shopping in a bustling cosmopolitan atmosphere with people from nearly 200 different countries in a city equally renowned for its historic and cutting-edge architecture and numerous rivers, waterways, lakes and landscaped parks – all this goes to create a city quite unlike any other with a marvellous quality of life.

berlin 2009[®] and its International Visitors

For what must be truly the most international sporting event in the world, the German capital is expecting to welcome some 1,800 athletes from the 213 Member Federations of the International Association of Athletics Federations. Around 3,000 officials, coaches, physiotherapists and ancillary staff will be on hand to support the athletes while 3,500 media representatives will be reporting on the exciting events in Berlin to the whole world.



Around 500,000 tickets are available for the competitions in the Olympic Stadium. The preliminary heats are held in the morning and the "finals" in the afternoon and evening are where the medals are awarded. With three to seven heats a day there will be no shortage of sporting highlights. *berlin 2009[®]* is a perfect blend of the international outlook of track and field athletics with the multi-cultural diversity of a great cosmopolitan city. So make sure that you too have your seat in the stadium where you can say hello to the whole world!

The Street Competitions

The rankings in the Marathon and Race Walking competitions offer another special highlight. For the first time these competitions will not begin and end in the Stadium but at the Brandenburg Gate in the centre of the city. You have to be there to experience the thrilling atmosphere for yourself as hundreds of thousands of excited fans from Berlin, Germany and the whole world pack the route cheering on the competitors. On top of this comes international TV broadcasting offering a showcase for Germany, its capital and international track and field athletics. The walkers' 20 and 50 km long races are held on Berlin's grand Unter den Linden Boulevard. Starting at the Pariser Platz the Marathon runners complete four ten-kilometre loops that take them past the key points of interest in Berlin's fast-moving city.
